## Drop Off and Pickup Changes and Updates

Please review the updated videos for drop off/pickup and written information on our website found [here](#). This information will ensure that all New Summit families understand our drop off and pickup process clearly.

- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students are combined with 2<sup>nd</sup> grade in the North Upper Lot, not the Xfinity lot. This is a change we made today to help with the flow of traffic.
- Parents, who have students that go to daycare, notify your student's teacher what daycare provider they attend.
- Siblings always go to the younger sibling pick up zones for both carpool pick up and walking. Walkers include if a parent is waiting outside the pickup doors to meet their students. Please indicate to your student and teacher that they are a walker not a carpool rider prior to pickup. The zones can be found in the link above on our website and in the video. Older siblings do not pick up their younger siblings in their classrooms. This prevents the mixing of cohorts. Please communicate with your students as to what zones they are to be picked up from and that they can find their siblings in the appropriate pickup zones.
- If you are changing your normal pick up process for that day, please notify the teacher and the Receptionist by 12:30 pm. We will need to change the pickup method in our Curb Smart program.
- Many students had not memorized their pickup numbers. Please be sure your child knows their pickup designated number.
- If you have an Elementary student and a Middle School student, we will **NOT** release the Elementary students until the 3:20 pm Middle School dismissal time. Please do not try and line up for Elementary dismissal time of 3:05 pm if you have a Middle School student.
