Instrument Rental Fee	TDB	Instrument fees will change depending on the brand of instrument, instrument availability, and what instrument is chosen. The following chart is an approximation.

Instrument	Plan A: 50% of all rental paid may apply towards the purchase of a new instrument of like kind.	Plan B: 100% of initial rental plus 75% of all subsequent rental paid may apply towards purchase of this instrument at its regular retail price.
Flutes, Clarinets	\$15 a month	\$20 a month
Trumpet, Trombone	\$15 a month	\$20 a month
Drum Kits (Percussion)	\$15 a month	\$20 a month
Alto Sax	\$25 a month	\$30 a month
Tenor Sax	\$25 a month	\$30 a month
Baritone	\$25 a month	\$30 a month

-  Students will be required to purchase the Essential Elements book for class, and it is approximately \$10.
-  Students will be responsible for maintenance and care of the instrument. This could include buying valve oil, slide grease, or reeds.
