masks

Masks are recommended, but not required for people who are not fully vaccinated, regardless of age.

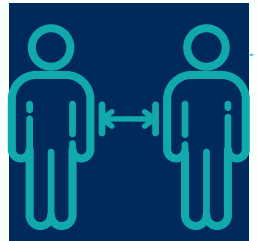


physical distance and space

3 feet between students if possible.

Students may move between classrooms and teachers.

Desks should be arranged as needed with 3 feet of distance if possible.



hand washing

Practice thorough hand washing and remind students to wash their hands as often as possible for 20 seconds and use hand wipes/sanitizer.



bathrooms and water fountains

Normal bathroom procedures. Continue to use bottle fillers rather than water fountains.



sharing supplies

Follow normal classroom procedures.



extracurricular, events and large groups get together

No limit on audience/spectators.

More than 10 people may gather together.

3 feet of distance between individuals if possible.

Try to play/practice outdoors.

Field trips and out-of-district travel will resume. On bus masking is required by all.

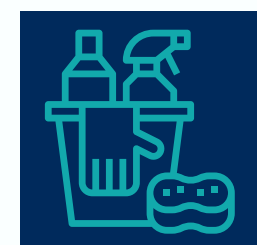


cleaning

Clean as regularly cleaned prior to COVID.

Cleaning products will be maintained by the facilities manager and ordered through them.

Additional cleaning protocols may be implemented, including the use of electrostatic disinfection and heightened for classrooms with excessive absences.



food

Normal cafeteria service. Students go through the Sodexo service line to pick up lunch and breakfast. (Lunch schedules will accommodate fewer classes in the cafeteria **if possible**.)

Students may utilize cafeteria tables. Consider spacing with 3 feet **if possible**.

Students will wash hands or use hand sanitizer when entering the cafeteria.



positive case

Positive COVID individuals will isolate/quarantine for 10 days since symptom onset, and at least 48 hours have passed since the resolution of fever without medication, and other COVID-19 symptoms have improved.



close contact

Contract tracing: to be done by NSCA COVID Task Force, Health Team or by the local health department.

Quarantine: If required will be handled by the NSCA Health Team or by the local health department.

Communication: NSCA will send notifications of positive cases to those affected and considered close contacts. We will follow the required guidance from our local health department regarding communication to the community.



temperature and symptom checks

NSCA will conduct "business as usual" and will not conduct daily temperature checks for staff, students, or visitors.

NSCA Health Team will perform needed temperature checks for symptomatic students.

Parents and staff will follow at home symptom checks before coming to school or work.



classroom volunteers

NSCA classroom volunteers shall not exceed 5 in any specific classroom.

Classroom parties will resume with prepackaged treats for consumption and no parent/guardians may attend at this time.

Parent volunteer training will be required and completed prior to volunteering.
