

# Our vision is to boldly reach new summits while positively influencing the world.

Inclement weather days will have the following vocabulary when communicating to staff, students, and families through ParentSquare messages and social media.

We are communicating with our community the updates to our inclement weather plan. Please read thoroughly or reference when there is communication regarding a weather delay or closure.

- **Full Closure Inclement Weather (NO REMOTE LEARNING unless snow days exceed two consecutive days):** The first two inclement weather days will be full closure days for ALL levels and buildings. These are essentially “traditional snow days.” ALL school facilities are **closed**. No students or staff report to school/work, and no formal teaching/learning occurs. Prodigy Childcare will **NOT** be available during a full closure.
  - After the district/school uses two full closure inclement weather days (snow days), the district/school will follow the model below.
- **Remote Learning Snow Day Closure (only if snow days exceed two consecutive days):** A remote learning lite day at home for Middle School students only. K-5 will not be expected to participate in remote learning, but remote learning options will be optional and available. All teachers and other instructional staff will be expected to work remotely to catch up on work. For Middle School students, the remote learning schedule will start two hours later than usual (Elementary staff only and Middle School 10:05 AM). No students or staff report to school/work, and all teaching/learning is performed remotely per our remote learning processes. Teachers will provide schedules and instructions for remote learning days, including expectations for specials and electives classes. Non-classroom teachers and other school staff will work from home and be available by phone/email during regularly scheduled work hours.
  - Preschool is canceled and closed on Full Closure Inclement Weather Days and Remote Learning Snow Days.
  - [Prodigy Childcare](#) **will be** available only during remote learning snow days. *Please see their protocols for further information, and your student must be registered beforehand.* They are not expected to provide remote learning access for the students. Families and students will be expected to complete work when home.
  - Due to no staff being expected to be at school on snow days, Chromebooks **WILL NOT** be available for students to complete remote learning while at Prodigy or home at this time.
- **Delayed Start:** 2-hour delayed start. The school will start two hours later than usual (Elementary and Middle School 10:05 AM). There will be no AM Preschool. Full-day Preschool will start at 10:05 AM, and PM Preschool will begin at their regular scheduled time. Prodigy Childcare will be available but with a delayed start time of 8 AM. Students may wear jeans with a uniform shirt. Breakfast will not be served, and lunch will be available as usual.



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- **Delayed Start (on an early release Wednesday):** Since it is an early release day, ALL students, including ALL Preschool, will have a traditional snow day unless it falls into the third day of a Full Closure Inclement Weather Day, in that case, students will follow the same procedures as for a remote learning snow day. Staff are scheduled to report on a delayed status. [Prodigy Childcare](#) **will be** available beginning at 8 AM.
  - **Early Release:** Occasionally, situations arise when the weather moves in mid-day, and we need to release students early. In these situations, parents will be notified by ParentSquare and our school's website and posted on social media. Parents will have one hour to pick up their students when communications are made. Come up with a plan that works with your family to ensure all students and staff can get home safely on these days.
