Skills to Practice

Literacy

- Can identify and write upper and lowercase letters
- Holds pencil correctly
- Can write first and last name
- Phonemic Awareness Skills and Activities:
 - Identify Rhyming Words
 - Breaking a word into the individual sounds - pad .../p/ /a/ /d/
 - Taking individual sounds and blending them to make a word - /t/ /a/ /g/...tag

Math

- Count to at least 20
- Identify and write numbers 0-9
- Count objects up to ten

Social

- Be able to tell someone their first and last name
- Be able to have a conversation with a person about their age, favorite things, and what they like to do

Self-Help Skills

- Use the restroom on their own (including wiping)
- Tying shoes
- Zip coats
- Snaps/buttons on pants
- Following two-step directions
- Asking for help
- Identify colors
